

ODHIN PROJECT

- Publication Guidelines -



An agreement based on the requirements of the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (www.icmje.org) will be included in the Consortium agreement.

Basic points:

- Whenever possible, and to promote equality of access as encouraged by the European Commission FP7 programme, manuscripts should be published in open access journals or in journals where open access can be provided through a fee to the project. (For assistance with this please contact the Coordinating Team (reynolds@clinic.ub.es)).
- Authorship and order in signatures established according to standard ICMJE criteria (http://www.icmje.org/ethical_1author.html).
- Conflicts of Interests statements added according to ISAJE criteria (<http://www.parint.org/isajewebsite/ethics.htm>; <http://www.parint.org/isajewebsite/farmcon.pdf>).
- All scientists participating in the relevant work packages for any paper will be consulted for comment, with adequate notice (at least 30 days before any article submission and 15 days before an abstract submission for public presentations), and/or involved as authors.
- Consulted scientists may comment but not change content and conclusions of a publication or presentation. However, if a partner's legitimate interests in relation to Foreground or Background can be shown to suffer, they may ask to have their proprietary confidential information and any Background and/or Foreground be deleted, and request a delay (60 days) to allow for the filing of a patent application.
- Authorship can include 'the ODHIN project'.
- A standard 'acknowledgments paragraph' must be included in papers published through the ODHIN project. (see below)
- Copies of all papers submitted and the final paper once accepted will be sent to the Coordinating Team (reynolds@clinic.ub.es).
- Once accepted, a protected PDF copy of the article will be e-mailed to all ODHIN partners.
